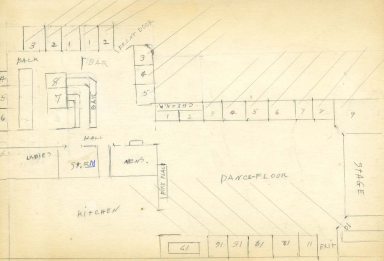

CONDITIONAL SALES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 28th day of March 1961, between
INDEPENDENT SHEET METAL CORP., a corporation, hereinafter called the seller, and O. R. Cleveland D.B.A.
The Jolly Roger of 5721 Rothell Way, Seattle, Washington
(City)
(an individual) (a corporation) (a partnership), hereinafter called the purchaser,

WITNESSETH: The seller hereby agrees to sell and the purchaser agrees to buy the personal property set forth and described in the enclosed "Exhibit A" for the sum of One thousand Two hundred Eight and no/100 - - - Dollars
Legal Money of the United States, of present standard, payable as follows:

\$1,100.00 - upon the signing of this agreement, and the balance in the sum of \$1,100.00 as follows:

1. Upon delivery, - \$100.00, plus Retail Sales Tax of \$34.16.
2. The purchaser agrees to pay the sum of \$1 - 50.00 on the 15th day of May 1961,
and the sum of \$1 - 50.00 on the 15th day of each and every month thereafter until the whole purchase price
shall have been paid.

For neon display to be installed on building located at the above address, as per
approved sketch.

Seller will not be responsible for any undertaking given verbally or otherwise which is not specified in the contract. It is
agreed that lumps, flasks or other accessories are NOT included in this sales agreement, and that purchaser is to supply or
change service wiring as required by city ordinance and consent to sign UNLESS it is specifically agreed as follows:

For double-tube neon border on building proper and tower.

For three sets of 18" letters reading "JOLLY ROGER" to have double-tube neon on
the face.

For flashing border tubing on top tower, so as to have a chasing effect.

For two neon tubes to be installed behind the glass bricks on the round corner
of the building and for flashing the same (First one tube on, then the other tube on,
and ~~then~~ both tubes on together).

For moving the Skull & Crossbones sign from the present location to the top of
the tower, and for installing tubing on the same so as to give the effect of the
flag straightening out.

For taking down the neon tubing reading "JOLLY ROGER" now on the tower, and
for taking down the double-faced sign reading "JOLLY ROGER" now on the East face of
the building.

For installing tubing on the word "DINERS" of the present sign.

It is HEREBY understood and agreed that this contract is not subject to custom-made and contains all previous understandings
either written or verbal, and does not become binding upon the seller until approved by an executive officer of the seller. This
agreement is taken by the seller subject to delays by strikes, breakage or other unforeseen commercial delays. It is expressly
understood that title to the merchandise or equipment covered by this contract shall not pass to the purchaser until all the payments
herein provided for have been made, and until the purchase price shall have been paid in full. In the event of a default
by the purchaser in the payment of any of the aforesaid due hereunder, then the entire unpaid balance of the purchase price shall
immediately be and become due and payable at the option of the seller and the seller shall have the right to either (1) resell
said property in payment of unpaid balance without legal process, or (2) without retaking said merchandise or equipment, to
bring suit for the balance due under this contract and in which case the purchaser agrees to pay interest at the rate of seven
per cent per annum on any amounts so due and owing after default, and in addition to pay the seller a reasonable sum as attorney's
fees in said suit. Time is of the essence of this agreement. Said merchandise or equipment shall not be deemed or claimed
by either party as a fixture.

That on full payment of said balance or purchase price and interest, the title to said property shall vest in the purchaser.

The said property and every part thereof at all times while out of the possession of the seller shall be at the risk of the
purchaser, and all loss or damage of said property or any part thereof shall be borne by said purchaser and no such loss or damage
shall operate to extinguish or diminish the liability of the purchaser upon this contract.

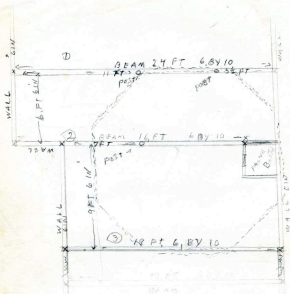
