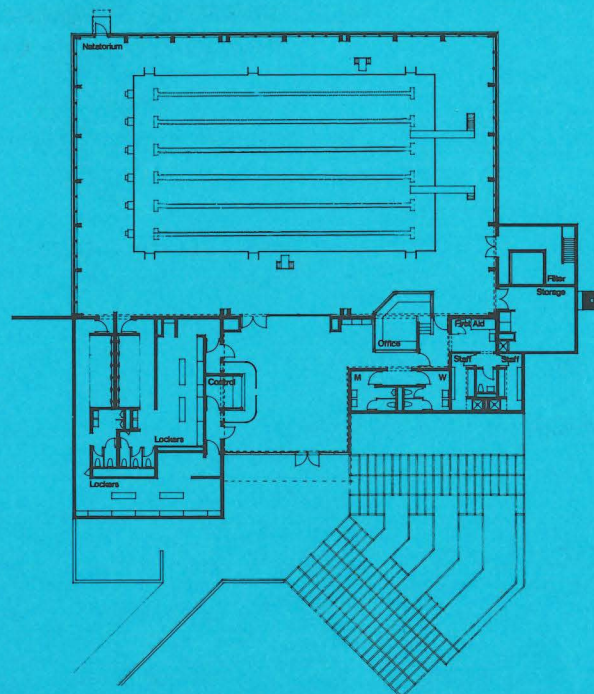

COST - \$825,000

BUILDING - 15,356 square feet

BUILDING MATERIALS - Glu-lam columns and beams with sawn timber purlins. Cement fiber decking, roof, and wall sheathing. Concrete masonry bearing walls. Wood shingle roofing and siding.

SKYLIGHTS - 2 clerestory windows with wire glass

CEILING HEIGHT - Varies, 38' in height

FLOOR - Broom finish concrete

GLAZING - Wire glass throughout

POOL SIZE - 44' x 75' 1"

POOL DEPTH - 3:0 x 12' 0"

GALLONS OF WATER - 200,000

WIDTH OF DECK - 15' N. & S. x 10' W. 16' 4" E.

POOL DECK DRAIN - Decko Drain, perforated stainless steel cover 3/4" wide, continuously around pool

POOL OVERFLOW SYSTEM - 12" wide, average 15" deep, serves as balancing deck

SIGHT AND BLIND LINE - Tapered hardboard railing on side of building, running the length of the pool to show exact depth of water.

FILTER - Swim Quip Mer-made - diatomaceous earth, five-hour turnover 420 square foot filter area, 30" x 36" rectangular filter elements

CHLORINATOR - 50 pound Fisher-Porter

LIGHTING - Underwater - 10 dry niche 500 watt lamps

Overhead - 4 tube fluorescent fixtures running continuously the length of pool providing indirect lighting

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT - Public address, record player, pool amplifier, intercom system, multiple portable system input jacks

COIN OPERATED LOCKERS - Stainless steel locker system, convertible from pay to free

DIVING STANDARDS - Cantilever, adjustable fulcrum, one 3-meter and one 1-meter - - specially designed safety hand rails

DIVING BOARDS - (2) Duraflex "maxiflex" 16' aluminum spring boards

COMPETITIVE LANES - (7) Kiefer-McNeil, non-turbulence racing lanes

LIFEGUARD TOWERS - Specially designed single pedestal - - two side ladders, equipped with p.a. and emergency buzzer

SAFETY LINE - (2) Kiefer-McNeil, with blue and white coilomatic floats

STARTING BLOCKS - Nor-Cal Champion take-off platforms

COMPETITIVE RACING CLOCKS - "Pace Clock" covered face, wall-mounted and portable

WATER POLO GOALS - Paragon designed to meet AAU standards

WATER SLIDE - Aquaslide deluxe line, queen size, left curve

SEATING - Portable bleachers

VENDING MACHINES - Space for four machines
